"An Ordinary on the Ground at 5s each, by Richardson from the Fountain. After the Gentlemen and Cricketers have dined, there will be an Ordinary at 1s 6d each." Tickets were available for the great Stand erected on the ground at one shilling. Performances at the Canterbury Theatre of 'The Jealous Wife' and 'The Miller of Mansfield' were "To begin as soon as the Cricketing is over." The final day of this match began with Sir Horace's team chasing 111 runs to win in their second innings.

The annual Ball was held at Bourne Park on Thursday, 16th. Kentish Gazette (14th August), regarding the Ball – "The temporary Room is already up: It is expected to be very numerously attended, and to make it more general, no particular Invitations have been sent." Kentish Gazette (17th August) – "The spectators, considering the unsettled state of the weather, were very numerous, and amongst them were his Grace the Duke of Dorset, the Marquis of Lansdown, the Earl of Thanet, Lord Lewisham, Sir John Honywood, John Sawbridge Esq. and most of the gentlemen in this part of the county. The ladies also made a very splendid appearance, and according to the usual hospitality at all times conspicuous at Bourn

House, there seemed to be provided by the liberal spirited owner of this delightful mansion, a continual round of amusements and entertainments for all his noble and respectable visitors.” Odds fluctuated heavily during this match, starting at 7 to 2 in favour of Hambledon but 30 to 1 at the commencement of the last innings.
